Dear colleagues,

We are pleased to invite you to take part in the 10th Annual Scientific and Practical Conference on Legal Regulation in the Digital Environment “Law and Information: The Questions of Theory and Practice”.

The conference will take place on December 4, 2020 in the Presidential library (St. Petersburg, Senatskaya Sq. 3) at 10:00. Registration of participants starts at 9:00. Conference format: in person and remote participation using video conferencing.

The main topics of the conference are issues of theory, law and practice, application, improvement of information and legal norms related to librarianship, legal aspects of the formation of the united electronic space of knowledge, access to legal information, information protection, legal regulation of the use of information technologies, development of electronic government, digital economy, media. The purpose of the event is to discuss the relevant results of scientific research of Russian and foreign information legislation, the experience of law enforcement in the digitalization process of modern society.

Scientists, teachers, applicants for academic degrees, heads and employees of state authorities and local governments, specialists from libraries and other organizations that provide public access to legal information are invited to participate in the conference.

It is possible to participate in the conference via videoconference system.

The expenses of the conference participants on travel and accommodation are not covered by organizers.

Scientific materials (articles, reports, reviews, etc.) prepared by the conference participants will be published in the scientific publication of the Presidential Library (Electronic Legislation Series. Issue 10).

Scientific publications of the Presidential Library are indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI). All materials are reviewed.

Materials are accepted until October 1, 2021 in electronic form to the email knyagin@prlib.ru .

The Presidential Library concludes licensing agreements with authors on the scope of rights to use their works, provides free access to electronic copies of scientific publications available on the website https://www.prlib.ru/publication_sbornik . Authors of articles do not receive any fee and do not pay for publication.

Articles, scientific reports and other materials should be in Russian. They should contain per page references, annotations, lists of keywords, captions for illustrations (if any), lists of references and sources, lists of abbreviations (if used). Illustrations should be sent in separate files with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. It is also necessary to put on the surname, name and patronymic (if any) of the author, place of work (study), position held, academic degree (if any), academic rank (if any). Surnames, names and patronymics of the authors and full information about them, titles of materials, annotations, keywords should be additionally provided in English.

By agreement with the editorial board, the materials may be sent in English for translation into Russian for publication by the publisher.

The volume of articles, reviews is from 0.35 to 1 print unit of 40,000 ens. The editorial board may make a reasoned decision to publish a larger article. The volume of scientific report can be up to 0.5 of print unit.
